

REQUIREMENTS FOR SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATIONS (FOR AUTHORS)

The articles on an actual theme, containing the results of deep scientific research, novelty and substantiation of the scientific conclusions of the corresponding purpose of the article, which have not be previously printed before, are considered for review before publication in the magazine. The articles should be correspond to some areas of knowledge. For example: Education and Pedagogy; Culture and Art; Theology; Sociology (Social sciences); Journalism; Management and administration; Law; Biology; Sciences of a nature; Mathematics and Statistics; Information Technology; Mechanical engineering; Electrical engineering; Automation and instrumentation; Chemistry and bioengineering; Electronics and Telecommunications; Production and technologies; Architecture and construction; Healthcare; Medicine; Social work; Service-sphere; Military Sciences; National security; Security of the state border; Civil security; Transport; Governance and administration; International relationships.

The authors bear complete responsibility for the experimental data provide in their manuscripts.

Editorial Board of the magazine reserves the right to reject articles that don't correspond to the requirements and theme of the magazine.

All materials, coming to the editorial board and corresponding to the theme of the magazine are subject to mandatory review with the participation of at least two experts, before publication.

The articles are accepted in Polish, English, Ukrainian, Russian and other languages of EU countries.

The file with the article must have:

1. Contact details (e-mail for the contact in the publishing process).
2. Information about authors (First and Last name, science rank, science grade, position, place of work or study, city/town, country).
3. The title of the article, annotation and keywords.
4. Financing information: grant or program (if available).
5. Text of article with the titles, filled out by borrowings and references to sources.

6. Acknowledgements (if available).

7. References.

The title of the article, the annotation and the key words must be given in Polish, English, and in the languages of the manuscripts. The first name and the last name must be transliterated in accordance with the applicable transliteration requirements of the author's country.

The structure of the manuscript

The title of the article should briefly inform about its contents and contain no more than 13 words.

The annotation (100 – 200 words)

The annotation should be clear and informative (not contain general phrases, secondary information). It should be meaningful (to show the main content of the article). It should contain an introductory word, a brief description of the methods of conducting research (1 – 2 sentences). It should contain description of the main results and concise conclusions or prospects for further research. You must use the terminology used in specialized international English-language magazines in your text. The annotation must be clear and without familiarizing with the main content of the article.

The keywords

6 – 8 words or phrases reflecting the specifics of the theme, but don't duplicate words from the title of the article.

The text of the article should contain the introduction, the main part and the conclusions.

The introduction

The introduction should contain a description of the research problems in the world scientific literature and the purpose of work.

The main part

The research tasks should be formulated. The purpose and tasks should be interconnected and reveal of the theme, stated in the title of work. The materials and methods of research, research results and their discussion should be presented.

The materials and methods of research

The material and methods of research are formed to be able to reproduce the research by the above description.

The results and discussion

The discussion and results are an outline of the main research material with the full justification of the scientific results. The results should be presented in a logical sequence in the text, tables and pictures. It is not necessary to duplicate and repeat the data of tables and pictures in the text. You must talk about their comparison only. Summarizing quantitative data, it is necessary to indicate not only relative (for example, percent), but also their absolute values, and also indicate which statistical methods have been applied for their analysis.

The discussion

The discussion contains only the interpretation of the results, but not their duplication and iteration. It is necessary to select new and important aspects of the conducted research, to analyze the possible mechanisms or interpretation of these data and to compare them with the data of other researchers, if it is possible. The discussion could include well-grounded recommendations for practice and possible perspectives for applying the results in the future studies.

The conclusion

The conclusions formulate the results of solving the problem indicated in the title and purpose of the article.

The acknowledgements (if it is necessary)

The references

All sources from the references should be quoted in the text of the article; otherwise, the corresponding element should be deleted. If the article with the link has a numeric identifier doi (<http://www.doi.org/index.html>), you must specify it. “References” is the references in English. It should be made in accordance with the requirements of the ARA standard (<http://www.apastyle.org/>). You may use the automatic converter (<http://reffor.us>) with all Cyrillic titles of articles and books

transliterated in Latin letters on the standard transliteration ISO 9:1995 (you may use the automatic transliterator <http://translit.kh.ua/?iso9>).

The references to used sources should be made in parentheses, which indicate the author's surname, the year of publication, the page to which you refer in the text. For example: Jones S. stated, “Students often had difficulty using APA style” (Jones, 1998, p. 199). The references should be formed in alphabetical order.

Technical arrangement

1. The volume of the main text of an article is not less than 8 full pages.
2. The margins – 2cm; the paragraph – 0,75 cm; the indent before and after paragraph - 0 (zero); the line interval is single.
3. The font is Times New Roman.
4. Arrangement of the article text:
 - The title of the article (center alignment, capital bold letters (bold font), the size of font is 12).
 - The first author’s name and the second author’s name (center alignment, normal letters, the bond font is 12).
 - Place of work, city/town, country (center alignment, cursive, 12).
 - Author’s e-mail (center alignment, 12).
 - The annotation – 1 indent is from 100 to 200 words, normal font, 10.
 - The keywords – 6 – 8 words or phrases by the theme of the article, normal font.
5. The main text of the article – normal font. The titles of subheadings of articles are highlighted in bold font.
6. The acknowledgements (if available). The font is normal.
7. The references. The font is normal, 9.
8. The appendices (if available). The font is normal.
9. You should differentiate the dash (–) and the hyphen (-) clearly.
10. It is forbidden to expand or to condense the intervals between letters.
11. It is forbidden to make the paragraphs by tabulations or by many spaces.
12. The only one space is between words. It is forbidden to expand the words by some spaces).

13. The quotation marks by format « » are used only.

14. There is non-breaking space between the initials and the last name.

15. In addition to the text, the full JPEG and JPG image elements are permitted only.

16. The graphic elements, made in graphic editors with high-quality parts, are allowed to use.

17. It is forbidden to use the scanned images made with a pencil or pen by hand.

18. It is forbidden to abuse the sizes of the tables (only in small volumes if necessary).

19. The format of the file for sending to the edition is DOC or RTF only.

The articles sends to the edition by electronic format and e-mail only.

All information about the author in the required form should be sent by e-mail, in addition to the main file.
